Popup Exhibit Projects bridge the boundary between exhibits and programs, and can be used both in the museum or outside the museum at community events. Storykiosk allows visitors to record their experience, and connect with email and social media.

Popup ArtSpace



- **Art based activities** can be set up quickly in museum and community spaces
- **Puppet-making** provides the initial theme – visitors create puppets related to the exhibit theme.
- **Followup activities** designed by artist/designer Amy Walsh engage visitors in art-making at home
- **Storykiosk** allows visitors to take a snapshot of what they made and talk about their experience.
- **Exhibit module** includes projected images of visitors puppets on the wall for added impact.

Popup MakerSpace

- **Modular maker exhibits** that are quick to set up in program spaces or community spaces.
- **Traditional animation devices** such as the praxinoscope, phenakistoscope, and others provide an opportunity for visitors to make. Devices designed and build by James Polk of Canstruct.
- **Followup activities** created by Paul Orselli (of POW!) are sent to visitors via email to continue the exploration
- **Storykiosk** allows visitors to take a snapshot of what they made and talk about their experience.
